Please note that the time available for each oral presentation is 15 minutes. Each speaker will have 15 minutes at his/her disposal: 10 minutes for the presentation, and 5 minutes for discussion.

The EHF Scientific Conference 2015 Book of Articles (conference documentation), which will be published after the Conference, will include the full articles of the medical mini-symposium, of all oral and poster presentations, as well as ten additional articles that have been provided but will not be presented at the Conference.
